AFRICAN CHURCH TESTIMONY BY AFRICAN FATHERS

"Adorka first became a member of our Church in 1924 at a town ten miles from Accra called Asofa where she resided with her husband.

"At her request a picture of the CHIEFS, ministers and members of the Church was given her which undoubtedly she took over to America.

"While she was with us here, we were all aware of the interest which she evinced concerning THE WORK SHE WAS TO PERFORM.

"HEART-SEARCHING AND REACHING WERE HER APPEALS AND PRAYERS, COUPLED WITH A DEEP SPIRITUAL TENDENCY WHICH ENTERTAINED THE HEARTS AND CAUSED TEARS TO FLOW FROM EVERY EYE.

"Her sincerity and faithfulness in the discharge of her duties both temporal and spiritual for THE BEBENEFIT OF YOU ALL OVER THERE AND US OUT HERE, ARE REMARKABLE.

"Though dead she liveth and speaks to us. We hear and will obey her command: MARCH ON TO VICTORY! This we are determined to do with God to help us for Jesus' sake, Amen.

THE SPIRIT OF THE LORD IS UPON ME, BECAUSE HE HATH ANOINTED ME TO PREACH THE GOSPEL TO THE POOR: HE HATH SENT ME TO HEAL THE BROKENHEARTED, TO PREACH DELIVERANCE TO THE CAPTIVES, AND RECOVERING OF SIGHT TO THE BLIND, TO SET AT LIBERTY THEM THAT ARE BRUISED, TO PREACH THE ACCEPTABLE YEAR OF THE LORD.

ALSO IN COUNCIL MEETINGS WITH NATURAL RULERS

Her temporal duties included Council Meetings with Natural Rulers and leaders which she attended in different areas in her part of Africa.

The same GOD who 'called' her had also visited her father the natural rulers and leaders of the people and by His Spirit moved them to endorse her mission to America and to supply her with documents, credentials and Power of Attorney to represent them. She was also supplied with samples of their products and raw materials and above all she was given a MESSAGE by them to their people in America.

Their Message of Welcome!

It is a message she never failed to repeat in all her public appearances. She would say:

"Your kings and leaders of Africa who are your fathers, and your native people who are your brothers and sisters, have also given me a MESSAGE to ask you:

They say, you have been a long time away from home: Why have you not made PREPARATIONS to come home? They say, If you want to come, let us know and if you don't want to come, let us know.

In the Gold Coast(now Ghana)of W. Africa there is a DOOR (to all Africa) open to you and a hearty welcome waiting for you there!

DEVIL ON HER TRAIL ON JOURNEY TO AMERICA

Adorka used to tell her children that the devil was on her trail from the day she accepted the Call in Africa. Even after she reached England from Africa, her journey was yet through great difficulties and hardships until she reached the United States by way of Canada. It is believed that she reached the United States sometime early in the year of 1926.

First Spoke in Negro Churches

During the brief and crowded months of Her Mission in the South it appears that their Mother had very little time or occasion to acquaint her children about her activities up north.

However she did occasionally mention to them that she sojourned a brief season in such cities as Detroit, Chicago and New York, that she spoke in churches, civic and fraternal organizations and although audiences were carried away with her message, yet the leaders would not accept her Program.

Then Linked up with U. N. I. A.

She then linked with with what was then the world famous Universal Negro Improvement Association. Here she became widely known as Madam Kofi and soon rose to the ranks of the foremost national speakers of that organization. After assassination, her children gathered that in cities like Detroit she did a great work taking in a lot of members for the U. N. I. A. there. She soon discovered that the high officers were using the organization for their own personal selfish interests so that Her Spirit led her to leave the north and do her own crusading in the south.

ADORKA INVADES DEEP SOUTH

When Adorka was next heard from, she was crusading in Alabama in the early fall of that year 1926. She invaded the deep south by way of New Orleans. It was later learned that she had made public appearances in the city of New Orleans and gathered followers who organized and still regard themselves as her children somewhere in that city to this day.

After New Orleans her Spirit moved her to go through Mississippi and northward to Selma in Alabama and thence southward to Mobile City in the State of Alabama.

It was as if Her Spirit was leading her in round about ways to find a port city that would be conveniently located for commercial relations between Africa and that area of the southland

Even before she went to Florida she often remarked to her officers in Mobile she liked Mobile as a port city having in mind the export and import business with Africa she came to bring to her race of people.

Without benefit of newspaper or radio public notices, and in less than six months, by the Spirit and Power of Her Old Man God, she captured the colored communities of that whole area of Mobile City with hundred of her children formed into Branches in the surrounding cities of Mobile, Prichard, Whistler, Cedar Grove etc.

Crowds thronged to her meetings and joined under their Mother.

"With Christ A Better Citizen"

She would take a chapter from a book of either the Old or New Testament, read or have read verse or groups of verses which she would explain and interpret to apply to the condition of her race of people and what her Old Man God would have His people to do about it.

It is in the course of these explanations and interpretations that she would often rise to heights of spiritual fervor and would make statements that at this day have become known as "Mother's Sacred Teachings and Prophecies."

People Enroll Their Names With Her

At the end of her Bible teaching she would invite those who had not yet joined under her to enroll their names with their Mother, extending her right hand, her voice would be heard saying:

"Enroll your names with your Mother children! If you don't have but one drop of black blood in you, and know you cannot pass for white, enroll your name."

Someone would lead in a spiritual, or hymn or gospel song, and at once men and women, young and old, many of them prominently known in their communities, would be seen rushing to shake her right hand and then anxiously wait in line for their turn to be recorded by the secretaries at the table. Many who had come to scorn were seen in line with those joining under their Mother. (Cont'd Next Page Please)

Such names included many of those who made it known that they had come to scorn at that bogus woman from Africa only to wind up being among the most zealous of her children.

A Conversion Example

Follows: A Testimony of Hard Believer

"My husband told me about Mother...When he first told me, I said: "What is she talking about? He said she is preaching and also talking about Africa. I SAID I DON'T WANT TO GO TO AFRICA. He said that she is talking a whole lot of good things.

"My husband one day said: I want you to go and join, I DONE JOINED". So I told him: "Well, maybe I'll go out there on Thursday night.

"On that Thursday I did not hurry because I was not interested, but the people told me to hurry and get there so I could get a seat..When I got there, it was a crowd all over the streets, but I happened to get a seat right in front of her.

"When she commenced to talking, it seemed as if it would burn me up in my heart because I had said such mean things which I should not have said about her.

"So I went to praying in my heart for forgiveness. I joined the same night. I had no idea before I went there as to what she would look like, but when I got there, I saw a pretty brown skin woman.

Her personality a Tower of Love

Adorka radiated so much love and cheer that crowds from her meetings joyfully went home talking about their 'Mother Kofi' and what Mother had said.

Wherever she chose to make her appearances the word would spread around town and by the second night, and without benefit of published notices, people would line the streets long before the opening hour and there would be no standing room inside, with many people turned away.

The Talk of The Town

The next day, one would find that the name "Mother Kofi" had become a household word and the talk of the town. People who were once total strangers to each other became welded into one huge family of love and warmest regards for one another as Mother's Children.

Among her followers, it became a popular form of greeting and hailing one another by saying: "Are you one of Mother's children?" More often than not the response would be a loud "Yes, I'm one of them!" and the parties would crowd in a joyful moment of conversation about their wonderful Mother and what Mother said.

All Classes Came to Her Meetings

Thousand saw and heard her in Church pulpits and in halls and in ball parks. Those who heard her for the first time and did not join, simply had to hear her again until even they proudly enrolled themselves as "Mother's Children."

Prominent preachers, Bible scholars and race leaders especially in the States of Florida and Alabama who for one reason or another found themselves attracted to her meetings came out admitting, as in the words of one of them:

NEVER A WOMAN SPAKE LIKE THIS IN OUR TIMES.

White Citizens Admire Her Leadership

Leading white professional and business citizens who had business dealing with her and had occasion to be in her meetings openly declared that THEY HAD NEVER SEEN ONE COLORED MAN OR WOMAN WHO COULD DRAW AND SO EASILY CONTROL SUCH VAST MULTITUDES OF COLORED PEOPLE AS DID THIS YOUNG COLORED WOMAN.

What Her Crowds Said About Her

Among the crowds who were her children, many said they followed her because she was bringing such a direct message from their Motherland Africa. Other emphasised that for the first time the Bible was being interpreted to them to see themselves as a part.

Many more regarded her as a Holy Woman who lived a CLEAN LIFE in the sight of God and man and that she was indeed a PRAYING WOMAN. They spoke of instances where through prayers she had healed sick cases which physicians had pronounced beyond medical cure. She welcomed and never was too busy to take more time with those of her children who were in less fortunate circumstances than the others

What She Looked Like To them

Those who saw her for the first time came out describing her as a beautiful brown skin woman of medium height in her early thirties with a head full of lovely hair but not straightened.

She wore only plain western style dresses and except for her rings and African-made gold brooch there was no other jewelry seen on her.

No fancy dress or gaudy robe was ever seen on her. Even as her children pointed out that our Lord Jesus Himself was plain of costume.

She walked with a light, quick step and there was something so unusual about her personality that her presence seemed to command respect and intense admiration from her audiences.

Her Interest in the Least of Her Children

Wherever she chose to make her residence, scores of her children would be seen around the house, some going to and fro and others just there to be around their Mother. They all marvelled at the cheerful, human bundle of tireless energy that she was.

She always saw to it that all her children around her were provided for. Always cheerful, yet she seemed happiest when she was at the table, eating and talking about Africa with her children.

She always made it a special point to take more time with and give attention to those in less fortunate circumstances.

Her children would talk about how their Mother enjoyed seeing them happy especially on the one occasion when she had the opportunity to attend a picnic with them in South Jacksonville.

Throughout the day, when not on the road, she was seen observing her Closet Prayer Period, engaged in conferences, attending to business downtown and working with her clerical staff.

After night meetings, she would be engaged in board meetings with her officers. On many occasions she would require her clerical staff to work with her after night meetings into the wee hours of the morning. In Jacksonville, where she established her headquarters she maintained her own poultry yard, feeding and attending to them herself when not out of town.

People Overjoyed By Greetings From Africa

People came out of her meetings overjoyed by greetings from Africa. They declared that this was the first time they had ever heard such good news and glad tidings from their people in motherland Africa.

They noted:

- (1) That it was a Message of greetings reminding them that they have been a long time away from home.
- (2) That it was a Message of Invitation asking "Why have you not made preparations to come home? "
- (3) That it was a Message of Welcome, saying "in the Gold Coast(now Ghana) there is a door open (to all Africa) to you and a hearty welcome waiting you there."

It was still a day when Negro missionaries, preachers, leaders and writers enjoyed a rich harvest of financial gain from their Negro audiences who seldom failed to respond generously to their eloquent appeals for what the people were made to believe were funds and more funds needed to 'Christianize' and civilize the benighted heathens of darkest Africa.

Adorka Tells of Africa's Progress

Against this background Adorka courageously and singlehandedly 'enlightened' her misinformed audiences. Indeed she was most successful in impressing upon her amazed listeners that contrary to what they had been made to believe, it is the natives who, in many countries of Africa, do own and control their own lands.

And since they owned and controlled their own lands it is the natives themselves who carried on the industries and commerce of their own countries, selling their raw materials to the markets of the world and in turn buying all kinds of manufactured goods.

She was telling them of cities operated and managed by African people, many of them with every modern convenience---of black mayors, city authorities, houses of legislature of Natural Rulers kings and leaders.

She would then emphasise that for all this progress in Africa which most Negroes never heard about, the surface had scarcely been scratched and that was her God-ordained mission to urge Negroes to participate in the development of their motherland for the benefit and welfare of all concerned.

Her children like to recall that although Mother spoke in English Her pronunciation and manner of speech was what they affectionately call her "African accent".

For the pronouns I and my she used "me" Example:
ME TELL ME OLD MAN GOD: "Thank'ee!"

For the pronouns he, she used "him". Example:
"GIVE HIM LONG ROPE AND HIM BREAK HIS OWN NECK."

Her children further point out that although our Lord Jesus was born a JEW, neither did he teach in his own Jewish language.

In His day his people of Galilee spoke a dialect of a once famous language known as Aramaic, originally from Mesopotamia and Syria, until Arabic succeeded it in that part of the world.

Many dialects of this Aramaic language were spoken and it was most popular in Palestine in the time of Christ.

" And I, brethren, when I came to you, came not with excellency of speech or of wisdom, declaring unto you the testimony of God.

" And I was with you in weakness, and in fear, and in much trembling. And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the SPIRIT AND POWER OF GOD.

" That your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the Power of God. (I Cor. 2:1,3-5)

Preachers Jealous of Her Mass Following 21

She was scarcely three months crusading on her Mission in Alabama when she found herself confronted with growing opposition from the ranks of leaders ministers who had become jealous of her mass following and violently opposed to her Bible teachings about God and Africa.

This was a situation she was to experience not only in Alabama but in every city where she established her Program. Church doors were locked against her so that she had to carry on her meetings in fraternal halls.

An Example

One night in a hall packed with preacher, leaders, and people of all ranks, one leading preacher walked out while she was speaking and offered the first motorcyle policeman he saw Ten Dollars telling him (the policeman) that Mother was in there preaching false doctrine and teaching Negroes to rebel against the white people.

The policeman came in and sat a while listening to Mother. After a while he walked out. The preacher followed behind and asked the policeman if he wasn't going to do something about it. The policeman replied: "What for? That woman is preaching the Gospel Truth and it is for everybody, she is speaking to you and I." The policeman rode off on his motorcycle and no more was heard from the \$10.

She became the subject of heated discussions in Ministerial Alliance meetings. There were ministers who spoke in her favor who believed in Mother they were threatened with reprisals, so they held their peace.

"Nevertheless among the chief and rulers (leaders) also MANY BELIEVED ON HIM; but because of the Pharisees they did not confess him, LEST THEY SHOULD BE PUT OUT OF THE SYNAGOGUE:" "For they loved the praise of men more than the praise of God".

Preachers Took To Their Pulpits Against Her

They took to their pulpits to discourage their church members from going to her meetings by saying: "That lying woman is an impostor. She did come from Africa. She is telling lies, that there is no part of Africa where Negroes can go except Liberia. Negroes haven't lost nothing in Africa. Negroes must think white, not black.

Then they threatened to expel from membership any of their members who attended her meetings let alone join that "Lying Woman". But the more the people flocked to her meetings and joined under their Mother.

Many Church Workers Question Leaders

Many among church workers asked their leaders: "If she is not from Africa and if she is preaching lies, then why don't you all go to her public meetings and expose her in front of all the people instead of saying such mean things about her behind her back?"

"And if she is telling the truth about Africa why don't you all fall in line with her for the good of the race?" Cont'd Next Page Please.

In Alabama, the crucial day came when Mother was to speak at "Brooklyn Park" in Mobile City. This location was then famous as the most popular, spacious and beautiful Ball Field and Recreation for colored people.

The park had been engaged to give an opportunity to all the people to see and hear Mother at one time, especially since the largest auditorium could not accomodate the crowds who attend her meetings.

Crowds overflowed to surrounding streets the Ministers' Alliance resolved to take advantage of this occasion and was known to have caused the presence of a large numbers of SHERIFFS AND POLICE.

Sheriffs and Police Hear Mother Speak

That is the day Mother spoke from the Book of the Prophet Isaiah 56, saying:

"...THEY ARE ALL DUMB DOGS...GREEDY DOGS WHICH NEVER HAVE ENOUGH AND THEY ARE SHEPHERDS THAT CANNOT UNDERSTAND: THEY ALL LOOK TO THEIR OWN WAY, EVERY ONE FOR HIS GAIN, FOR HIS QUARTERS. (Is. 56:10-11).

"AUTHORITIES TOLD PREACHERS:
THEY ALL NEED TO PREACH LIKE THAT AFRICAN WOMAN!"

And so many of Africa's Children enrolled their names with their Mother. In the meantime Her Fame had spread throughout the State of Alabama and surrounding States urgent invitations requesting her appearance.

By the month of June of the year 1927, Adorka was already established in a number of cities and towns throughout the State of Florida, with two big branches in the city of Jacksonville, another one in South Jacksonville, and in the cities of Tampa, St. Petersburg, West Palm Beach and Miami.

Delegates from parts in Georgia are known to have called on her to visit their home towns and in other places large groups were gathering themselves awaiting the day of her appearance.

Mother Reveals Jacksonville So Near to Africa

On arrival in Jacksonville, Mother was even more impressed with the port of Jacksonville. It was years later that Her children learned that Jacksonville in the United States is the nearest location between points in west Africa, across the Atlantic waters. They realized what Mother had so often said:

"Children, it's only a thread between you and Africa.

The people wondered why their leaders had made them to believe that Africa was really so far, far away. She had even told her children that the location known as Commodore Point in the port of Jacksonville could be developed as a shipping dock for the import and export business she had in mind.

Enemies Campaign Against Her

In spite of bitter campaigns against her from Pulpits, by Newspaper Articles and Public Notices, the more crowds lined up for blocks, hours before opening time, to gain entrance to their Mother's Meetings.

BIG LEADERS ATTEND BIGGEST NEGRO MASS MEETING of the times in Jacksonville to expose Mother for the liar they said she was. Meeting was held in famed modern Masonic Temple Building, a spacious auditorium on 2nd Floor. Led by Grand Master D. D. Powell, rostrum was full of local dignitaries.

Crowds on both sides of Broad Street Sidewalk extended clear to Ashley Street. Auditorium so packed and hallway and stairs until Fire Department Inspector ordered some of the people moved out.

It was quite a night. Her children declare their Mother preached the same Program she came to bring even with more spirit and power of God.

At the end she allowed a period for questions by the dignitaries. (This is the period that a young preacher in the audience broke the hushed silence by shouting):

Aha! Aha! "They're all in here Mother and not a dog will move his tongue now!....If you all can't condemn her now, you all can't preach to me no more!"

Adorka proceeded to invite her children to enroll their names with their Mother, singing went on, crowds flocked to give her their right and enroll. Dignitaries were seen sheepishly leaving by the side door. It was the NIGHT OF NIGHTS.

But they went away to plan and plot how that they might **STOP THAT WOMAN AT ALL COSTS.**

Mother Journeys to Atlanta, Ga.
Runs meetings and draws crowds

In the face of so many lies circulated against her, Mother journeyed to consult with Mr. Garvey. It was her desire that Mr. Garvey would realize that he was being fed a pack of lies even by HIS OWN CABINET, that he was being used to gain their own selfish ends.

For the few days she was in Atlanta, this campaigner also launched mass meetings and actually revived the Atlanta Division(Branch).

For the few days that she was in Atlanta, this Campaigner also crowded in mass meetings and revived the withering UNIA Division(Branch)there.

In a documentary testimony the UNIA Secretary and Representative of that area wrote and among other things said:

"Madam Kofi cause many people to join the U. N. I. A. while here."

This is the secretary who, years later, moved to Jacksonville and joined Mother's Church there.

Mr. Garvey Influenced against Her.

When Mother returned from Atlanta she reported to her children that she found Mr. Garvey overwhelmingly influenced against her by preachers and members of HIS OWN CABINET. So he decided against Mother.

This is the same group of men that Mr. Garvey later discovered and exposed calling them a bunch of crooks

Glimpse---Riot Meetings In Her Absence

During her absence, while in Atlanta, "wolves in sheep clothing" caused riotous meetings among her children in Jacksonville and South Jacksonville.. On two occasions quelled by Police Riot Squad.

...But when Mother was present on any such occasions she would easily restore order by simply standing up, waving her hand and say: "Quiet Children!"

Evening Campaign Against Mother Intensified

Some preachers are known to have raised funds in their churches declaring THAT WOMAN MUST BE STOPPED, RUN OUT OF TOWN OR BE DEPORTED.

And now it was the Big Man next to Mr. Garvey himself, the Acting President General who moved from New York to Atlanta to be close to Mr. Garvey while directing the campaign against Mother in Jacksonville.

Articles published in the "Negro World" under Mr. Garvey's name. "Negro World" in those days the foremost widely read colored weekly.....

Telegrams from Atlanta published in colored page of local daily newspapers against Mother. Secretly held meetings by preachers and leaders planning and plotting---leading up to MOTHER'S MIDNIGHT ARREST. Yet the more people flocked to her meetings and joined under their Mother.

"FOR THIS THING WAS NOT DONE IN A CORNER"

Glimpse, Jacksonville

CALLED OUT OF BED, JAILED, DEAD OF NIGHT on Saturday night before the 4th Sunday in September...Powerful combination of leading preachers, leaders and U.N.I.A. Executives determined to have her sentenced for a term in prison and then deported out of the country.

Also made sure she would be out of circulation since bonding offices closed all day on Sunday...By dawn that Sunday morning, her children quietly and orderly swarmed whole block on Liberty Street where Police Station was located and on to surrounding blocks.

Many others gathered at her residence on Florida Avenue, in meeting halls, PRAYERS OFFERED, PRAYERS ANSWERED. Mother released that Sunday noon for her sons to pay bond that Monday.

Out of Jail She Speaks to Her Children

The Story of Her Public Ministry goes on to relate Mother was rushed home, freshened up, would not take a rest, had her sons to rush her to the Prince Hall Masons building where her children were gathered since early morning.

This building was a modern three-story half a block brick structure facing State Street between Broad and Clay Streets, Spacious auditorium on 2nd Floor no standing room and no passing room in hallway and stair

Throngs for blocks long on each side of the street as hardly any passing room for the press. Many on rooftops facing platform on 2nd floor, cars bumper to bumper for four blocks long...Extra police on duty were seen cooperating with orderly movement of people, inside her children singing and imploring their Mother God.

Out of Jail Speaks to Her Children

In spite of ordeal, Mother was seen to be more cheerful than even before...She seemed to be amused as she related her experiences as a prisoner. Her children called it the Christ-Spirit in her.

On way to prison, Police car stopped to pick up unruly "drunk" disturbing the neighborhood that time of the night...He was put in the back seat with her...carried on with his vile language until one of the Police rebuked him:

"Shut up boy!" That's the Princess sitting back there! Mother said not another word was heard from him.

She also told her children that HER ENEMIES CAUSED HER TO BE STRIPPED NAKED IN JAIL. They claimed her power came not from God but from the roots on her body, but none was found on her.....

She also spoke of a police Officer who told her about her race of people and he said:

"Princess, we did not put you in here, your own people got you in here!"

THAT FOLLOWING WEEK SHE WAS TO BE IN COURT.

PRELIMINARY HEARING IN COURT, Jacksonville

It turned out to be a day long session before Justice of the Peace, Madison. Poerful enemies had case well organized. From within Mother's own ranks they had secured officers and responsible members to swear the warrants against her.

Those who swore warrants were also among those who first welcomed her in Jacksonville. The President of the local organization, the Treasurer, the Secretary and two others also of repute.

Among the charges: That Mother was lying and defrauding the people about Going Back to Africa, That she took a dollar from each one of them to pay their fare back to Africa...That she told them in Gold Coast streets paved with gold 40 miles long.....

That in Africa a man can have as many wives as he wants and that she was teaching them to rebel against the whites, and much more.

It is said that Mother's enemies had bribed Negroes to bear false witness against her. Indeed, the Justice of the Peace himself would not dismiss the case but referred it to Criminal Court. So Mother was out on Bond.

So was our Lord Jesus falsely accused by the Priests in their Jewish Council and before Pontius Pilate.
(St. John 18)

Refer to Trial--Hearing

The Executive in Jacksonville was known to be in communication with the preachers.....

While in Jacksonville, he lived at the first class Richmond Hotel on Broad Street. He was daily seen going to and fro in a black limousine driven by a uniformed chaffuer.

He was accompanied to court by a private secretary, a bodyguard and a white man whose identity was not publicly established.

It is known that the preachers who persecuted Mother, many of them came to no good end. And of the UNIA Executives, the following is only a part of what Mr. Garvey had to say about them in a long article published under his name in the Negro World:

"One J. A. Craigen and those men reaped a wonderful financial harvest out of the organization (UNIA) during my imprisonment.....

"They rode from one part of the United States to the other in Parlor Cars, spending the organization's money most riotously.

"They started a campaign to ABUSE ME when I refused to allow them license to continue robbing the people.

"Ask those villians and rascals what they have done with the monies they have collected from the American public in the name of Marcus Garvey."
(Vo. XXIX-No. 11)

Out on Bond----Mother Carries On

Out on bond, Mother continued on with her mission. She kept on the road from Branch to Branch teaching and prophesying, and hobbling her children even as a hen hobbles her chicks...She was also urging her children to keep on raising funds for machinery for Africa.

ON THE AFTERNOON of March 8, 1928 our Sainted Mother remained in her room in Miami in Closet Prayer, as was her daily custom, coming out only at intervals with tears streaming down her cheeks, to comfort and cheer her beloved children gathered in the front room to greet their beloved Mother. Her last act at the house was to play on the victrola: "Roll on, Sweet Moments, Roll On."

ON THE NIGHT OF THE ASSASSINATION, about the hour of 9p.m., Africa's Mother was already addressing her crowd of children in the hall from the Gospel according to Saint John 14.

As if knowing she was to pay the price that night, she ordered the guard, at the side-door near the rostrum, from whence the bullet later was to come to be seated. It was not long afterward, while speaking from the same Gospel, when a bullet unerringly aimed from a crack of the same door, broke the peaceful quiet whizzing its deathly way to the rostrum and fatally pierced her in the head.

An accomplice was immediately discovered inside the hall and mercilessly beaten to death by the enraged people. The assassin successfully escaping in the excitement, soon thereafter, was reported to have run himself into a cruel and horrible destruction.

She said they could build these houses with these diamonds and these rocks if they mind to and they shine so bright until they would have to smear cement over them. "I don't savvy to talk no lie on topside of de earth."

"And all of the juries got up and walked around to this glass and looked and looked and picked up the rock and looked at it. And the Judge looked at it.

"Then the Judge said to her: "If you can do anything with these ignorant Negroes, you'll do more than anybody has. We have never been able to do anything with them.

Mother was discharged on all counts.

As Told By (Dw.) Gladys Hall Porter
And Witnessed By Her Children

Charges Fee to View Body

"When Mother's Body was at Huff's, he had her in a casket in front of the Undertaker Parlor. For over two months people used to pay to go in and out every day to see Her. He first charged 25¢, then 20¢ until he came down to 10¢ as the crowds began to dwindle.

Body Moved From Front

"So when the line ceased, the body was moved from the front. Not seeing the body in front, the people of the Church got upset about it so much until they called a Committee of five women namely: Mrs. Davis, Mrs. Moore, Myself, and Mrs. Bines, and one more lady, I can't remember her name.

Committee Quarrels With Undertaker

"When we went to the Undertaker, Mrs. Davis Mrs. Moore and this lady (I can't remember her name), they started charging at the Undertaker, raising their voices and threatening him about Mother. So Mrs. Bines and myself stood aside and listened.

"They raised so much sand until Mr. Huff asked them out of his building. They went out in front and they still charged. He threatened to call a policeman and they left.

Undertaker Talks With Remaining Committee

"After they left, I asked Mr. Huff to please give us a statement, just a written statement to take back to the people because there were so many rumors out since the Body was moved from the front. I also said I was so sorry our people had acted like they did.

Undertaker Tells About Mother's Body

"So he asked us to have a seat, Mrs. Bines and myself, and he sat down and went on to explain why the Body was not in the front.

"Fog Inside the Casket", he said

"He said one day as he passed by the Casket he noticed "a fog" across the glass top inside the casket. He stopped and opened the casket. He said when he opened the casket he noticed it was wet with perspiration inside. He said the water was dripping from the top of the glass in the casket.

He Consults Other Undertakers

"He said it was so much so until he got excited about it, and he began to call different Undertakers out of town whom he knew had been in business far longer than he had. He said he called and called and could not get any information.

Phone Undertaker in Chicago

"He said he thought about an Undertaker in Chicago that he knew had been in business around fifty years. This Undertaker told him to take the Body from the Casket and put it where he could varnish it every day. That was all he could tell him to do.

"So he took the Body from the casket and put it in the embalming room where he could get to it everyday. The Undertaker in Chicago told Mr. Huff that was all he could tell him to do.

The Body in Embalming Room

"So he took the Body from the casket and put it in the embalming room where he could get to it everyday. He said he sent the casket back to the factory to be relined.

"Mr. Huff said it was against the orders of the Board of Health to let anybody into the embalming room except his help, but he did admit us to go and see Mother's Body where he had it on a beautiful white table with a white sheet over it where he could varnish it every day.

That's why the Body was out of the casket waiting for the word to put the Body away.
